James is a diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics, a Fellow of the American Academy of Maxillofacial Prosthetics, and a Fellow of the Academy of Prosthodontics. He enjoys active involvement in many different organizations, lecturing domestically and internationally, publishing, and providing prosthodontic outreach care.
